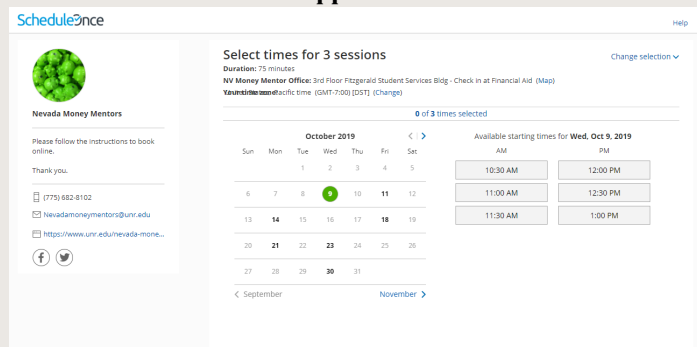

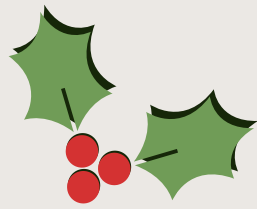
NMM Website Gets a New Look!

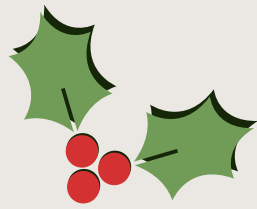

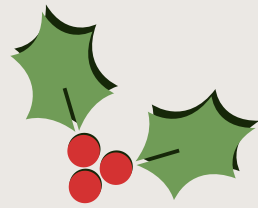

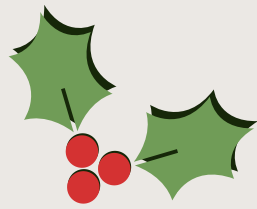
What We've Been Up To (Continued)

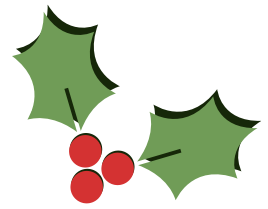
