Our mission is financial empowerment and self-sufficiency for all Nevadans, with a focus on keeping people housed and reducing poverty. We do this with proven solutions that work, community collaboration, and continued program success.

Every participant sponsorship of \$2,000 potentially provides a return on investment of \$7,300 in Nevada tax savings within the first year. Invest in a solution that works.



Bridges Out of Poverty training opens conversation with service providers and businesses whose daily work connects them with the lives of people in poverty. Bridges training helps employers, community organizations, and social service agencies address and reduce poverty in a facilitated comprehensive way. Attendees give Bridges training an 88% "Above Satisfaction" rating and likelihood of strategy implementation.



EmpowerNV is a 16 workshop series - where investigative participants research the resources of their community, and the obstacles and gaps to getting ahead. Participant investigators receive stipends for their participation providing critical information the community can use to take action to end poverty. Graduates connect with community allies who support them on their path to economic sustainability. The ability to think of the future while living in chaos is something investigators learn in EmpowerNV. According to research studies, active participants will see significant improvements within the first 170 days. EmpowerNV has a 77% graduation rate; alumni realized a 50% increase in resource assets, 45% increase in wellness stability, 35% increase in income and assets, and 10% decrease in debt and social service benefits.



Financial Empowerment one-day workshop topics include saving and spending plans, wellness stability assessment, building family wealth, financial calculators, your credit score, and home ownership. Attendees give an 88% "Above Satisfaction" rating and 100% feel more hopeful afterward.

Financial Navigator Program works directly with Nevadans, FREE of cost, to craft a Saving and Spending Plan to better understand the household budget and makes meaningful referrals to improve their personal stability. Over 3,816 referred clients are being assisted by 198 organizations.
